



Dr. Marvin Malyska Bursary

DESCRIPTION:

A grant obtained by the Winnipeg Foundation to support the ongoing learning and development of any staff of Seven Oaks General Hospital, including practicing physicians, related to mental health. It will be considered as funding for an individual or individuals to support further education and experience in the mental health field. The grant may be used for education, training and experience in the following areas:

1. Mental Health conditions in the Elderly
2. Psychiatric Nursing, Social Work or Psychology
3. Treatment of Adult Mental Health conditions
4. Substance abuse/addiction therapies
5. Personality disorders

The above list may be expanded to include other relevant, related programs and courses at the discretion of the approval team.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY:

Candidates shall be employed by the Seven Oaks General Hospital or be physicians practicing at this site, who have an interest in Mental Health and who can demonstrate the need for furthering their knowledge in their work at Seven Oaks General Hospital. Priority will be given to full-time employees who have been employed by the Hospital for at least two years. The successful candidate must provide a one year service commitment to Seven Oaks General Hospital in exchange for the grant.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- The Bursary Application forms can be obtained through Intra Links under Education.
- Students shall submit a cover letter along with the completed Bursary Application by **April 30, 2021**. The cover letter should include a description of how the educational program will enhance their contributions to service delivery at SOGH, or benefit the community at large.
- Successful applicants will be expected to provide an educational presentation at a designated hospital forum on their return.

SELECTION PROCESS:

Preference shall be given to requests with a specific focus on Geriatric Mental Health and Substance abuse/addictions therapies. The Chief Executive Officer shall determine the bursary awards based on the potential benefit to both Seven Oaks General Hospital and the applicant.
