Ken Seaford Memorial Bursary Fund

DESCRIPTION:

The Ken Seaford Memorial Bursary was established by Mr. Gus Seaford in memory of his son, Ken Seaford. Raised in North Winnipeg, Ken Seaford was a well-respected teacher, active in community affairs & had Ken Seaford Junior High School named in his honour.

Established in 1981, funds from the Ken Seaford Memorial Bursary are to be used to support management education for employees of Seven Oaks General Hospital.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY:

Employees of Seven Oaks General Hospital are eligible to apply for the bursary. The number of employees selected each year is dependent upon funds available for disbursement.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Applicants should submit completed applications, along with a letter of support from their Program/Service Director by **June 15, 2020**

SELECTION PROCESS:

- The Chief Executive Officer shall determine the bursary awards based on the potential benefit to both Seven Oaks General Hospital and the employee.

OTHER INFORMATION:

Generally, the Ken Seaford Fund provides for tuition, books and travel expenses for the first year of each successful candidate's course work. When requests for the bursary exceed the annual amount of funds available, partial funding may be provided in order to assist more staff.

Books paid for by the Fund are the property of the Seven Oaks General Hospital and are loaned by the Library for the duration of the course.
