

Gudmundur Myrdal Bursary

DESCRIPTION:

In tribute to Gudmundur Myrdal, the first Executive Director of Seven Oaks General Hospital from 1972 to 1985, a bursary has been established by the Hospital's Board of Trustees to assist full-time students, who are entering or continuing with post-secondary studies in any of the health professions. The successful applicant shall receive an award up to \$500.00, to be paid directly to the educational institution, towards their tuition.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY:

Candidates must be enrolled or accepted for enrolment in a post-secondary educational institution on a full-time basis in a **health service program of study**. Should any member of the Selection Committee have a family member as an applicant the Board of Trustee member must withdraw from the Selection Committee. Preference will be given to Manitoba residents living in the catchment area of Seven Oaks General Hospital, from the Canadian Pacific Railway tracks north, west of the Red River, north to the Perimeter highway, and including Rural Municipal of West St. Paul. All other factors being equal, individuals who have served as volunteers for the Hospital will be given additional consideration.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- The Bursary Application form can be obtained through the SOGH Website and Intra Links under Education.
- Students shall submit a cover letter along with the completed application by May 31, 2024

SELECTION PROCESS:

• The SOGH Executive Team shall determine the bursary awards based on the potential benefit to both Seven Oaks General Hospital and the applicant.
